

# Public Service Communications Training Net Script

1<sup>st</sup> Thursday 12:30PM local time

146.700 (-) Mhz tone 127.3

*Italic type* – spoken by NECOS

Regular type – advisory information for NECOS

## Opening:

*CQ Public Service Communications Net Operators.*

*This is [call sign], net control station for the Public Service Communications Training Net.*

*This is a directed net.*

*The purpose of this net is to*

- *provide training in emergency operation,*
- *develop Metro emergency communications, and*
- *provide fellowship for regular participants.*

*All stations are welcome to participate.*

*Please transmit only when requested to. Stations with emergency traffic may break the net at any time using their callsign and the proword OVER.*

*This is a directed net. All stations use the proword OVER or proword OUT at the end of your transmission.*

*I am your net control station, [call sign]. My name is [your name] and I am located in [your city].*

*Stations for the net, please call [call sign] state; your call sign phonetically, first name, location, and precedence and destination of your traffic. (OVER)*

Acknowledge stations checking in by listing their callsigns and ending the list with the proword *ROGER*, (*OUT*).

- or -

*No Station heard. (OUT)*

Acknowledge the stations checking in by listing the call signs and ending the list with the proword *ROGER*. DO NOT make conversation with individuals during the check-in.

*Additional stations for the Public Service Training net please call [call sign], state your callsign phonetically, first name, location. This is a directed net. All stations use the proword OVER or proword OUT at the end of your transmission. (OVER)*

IF there is traffic, add;

*The net is holding (state precedence – routine, welfare, priority, EMERGENCY) traffic for (list destination). Stations indicate traffic you can accept when checking in. (OVER)*

IF the NECOS believes there might be stations that cannot copy his station, ask for relays by stating:

*Are there any relays? OVER.*

If there are relays acknowledge the new check-ins after calling the relaying station. If there are no relays, conclude the net call with “*No Stations heard, OUT*”

### **Back-up NECOS**

This is (NECOS callsign) , (Back-up NECOS call) You will serve as back-up net control. Maintain a duplicate log. OUT

### **NET ID: Every 10 minutes**

*This is the Public Service Communications Training net. This is a directed net. All stations use the proword OVER or proword OUT at the end of your transmission. [your call] (OUT)*

### **NET ID plus ADDITIONAL STATIONS**

*This is the Public Service Communications Training net. This is a directed net. All stations use the proword OVER or proword OUT at the end of your transmission. Additional stations for this net please call [ call sign ] , state; your callsign phonetically , first name, location, and precedence and destination of your messages. (OVER)*

Direct the distribution of any Emergency or Priority traffic held by the net.

*Are there any announcements or bulletins for this net? Please call [call sign ]. (OVER)*

Acknowledge the stations announcements, bulletins, or training, by listing the call signs and ending the list with the proword ROGER.

ANNOUNCEMENTS & BULLETINS: Call the stations listing information and ask them to pass their information.

### **NET ID: Every 10 minutes**

*This is the Public Service Communications Training net. This is a directed net. All stations use the proword OVER or proword OUT at the end of your transmission, [your call] (OUT)*

TRAINING: If there is a training topic for the session, turn the net over to the station listing the training topic under the call for announcements or bulletins.

ROLL-CALL COMMENTS: Call the stations one by one and ask them for their comments for the net. Use the proword OUT when finished with an individual station.

### **NET ID: Every 10 minutes**

*This is the Public Service Communications Training net. This is a directed net. All stations use the proword OVER or proword OUT at the end of your transmission. [your call] (OUT)*

### **ADDITIONAL BUSINESS or TRAFFIC**

*Is there additional traffic or additional business for this net? Call [ call sign ], state; your callsign, first name, location, and precedence and destination of your messages. This is a directed net. All stations use the proword OVER or proword OUT at the end of your transmission. (OVER)*

Handle any additional traffic or comments.

- or -

*No station heard. (OUT)*

**Closing:**

*Thank you to all stations that checked in. This net will meet again next     (date)      
at     (time)    . This is [call sign] securing the Public Service Communications Training  
net at [date and time].*

Helpful Tips

- **Training is a major role for the NECOS.** Make note of procedural errors while the net is in progress and take time to demonstrate correct procedure.
- Keep a list of ARES stations near your notepad when you are NECOS. It helps with names and cities.
- Remember this is a training net, try to lead by example and if you feel comfortable, offer corrections in a constructive manner.
